Fund to Cure Stroke

a NEW Grant Program

Purpose:

To advance the institution's research mission, focus efforts on Stroke, and provide seed money to faculty members to advance/develop their individual research programs. Proposals should include one or more of the following:

- 1) Develop new stroke therapies and promote their translation into clinical care, the primary focus of the Grant Program;
- 2) Develop improved diagnosis, diagnostic imaging, and care of strokes;
- 3) Develop improved methods of stroke prevention, treatment, and rehabilitation; or to
- (4) Develop clinical and pre-clinical stroke-related research.

Eligibility:

Awards made only to full-time UAMS (including those with VA appointments) faculty members and part-time (>50%) faculty members at the rank of instructor or above. Individuals in temporary positions are not eligible. Fellows (clinical/postdoctoral) may be funded by projects led by faculty.

Application Process:

Submit to the COM Office of the Executive Assoc. Dean for Research, 686-5347. The deadline for receipt of a completed application is close of business on April 1 or October 1 of each year. See [Fund to Cure Stroke Grant \(link\)](#) for application info.
