"UAMS was well represented at the recent 65th Annual Meeting of the National Council of University Research Administrators in Washington D.C. the first week of August.

Members of the Office of Research and Sponsored Programs (ORSP), Office of Sponsored Programs Administrative Network (OSPAN), and Grants Accounting attended workshops and various breakout sessions to discuss a wide variety of relevant research administration topics. Topics included updates from federal agencies who sponsor research (NIH, NSF, etc.); Research administrator support of Principal Investigators; and many other current issues facing University researchers and research administrators.

The OSPAN staff returned from the conference and immediately formed internal committees to look at ways to address the relationship between OSPAN research administrators and the faculty that they support. How can we improve the cooperation/collaboration between the RA and the department? How can we improve the support of the Principal Investigator? Where can steps be implemented to improve workflow between ORSP/OSPAN/Grants Accounting and the departments? There were so many areas/opportunities identified that the staff returned fully charged to identify and implement improvements or clarify current procedures." 
