# **Getting Started with Pivot-RP**




#### **Create an Account**

- You must 'Create an Account' to get started with searching Pivot-RP, saving searches, tracking opportunities, getting automated funding alerts and/or claiming and editing your profile.
- Depending on your entry point to Pivot-RP you will find the create account option on the login screen, home dashboard or in the upper right of any screen








## Use SSO or Username/Password to Create an Account


## Option 1: Use Email Address/Create Password

(Pivot-RP does not accept personal emails such as @gmail, @yahoo, etc.)

Choose your institution from the Affiliated Member Institution dropdown list.



Select your Institution from the pulldown menu below and click Create my Account.


If your institution is not listed, you can still create an account with your email and by creating password



## Log in via your Institutional Login Page


Pivot-RP will direct you to your institution's central authentication page

#### **Confirm Email Address**




After logging in via your Institution credentials, you will be redirected back to Pivot-RP and prompted to confirm your name and email address as well as provide consent.

# For first time users


After creating an account and logging in for the first time, Pivot-RP will automatically search for a user's profile and prompt the user to claim their profile



#### Claim Your Profile workflow

**Note:** If more than one potential profile match exists, users will be directed to a page to select the appropriate profile from the list of matches.

If no potential profile exists, users will be prompted to create a profile



## Users are not required to Claim a Profile






Users can skip the profile claim process if desired and can always claim a profile later by navigating to "claim profile" under the personal navigation menu under their name

Though not required, it is highly recommended that users claim a profile. Claiming a profile allows users to get automated Pivot-RP Advisor recommendations.



## **Editing and Updating Profiles**

- Once a profile is claimed, a user can edit or update any of the content on the profile
- Users can assign one or more proxies to edit profiles on their behalf



**Changing your Account Information** 


Select "Change account info" from the menu under your name.
